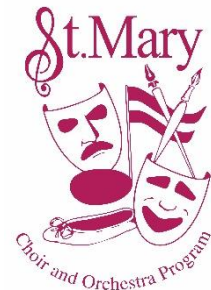
St. Mary Catholic School Choir and Orchestra Program

If you are going to the Samko & Miko Toy Warehouse sale at the Western Fair Agriplex from Nov. 15-18, your purchases can make money for the school. When checking out, simply tell the cashier that you are with the Assumption Catholic School group and they will stamp your receipt. Send your receipt to the school by Nov. 20 and the school will receive a cheque for 10% of the total purchase amount. **Only stamped original receipts will be accepted.** Stores will accept a photocopy or scan of the receipt if you need to return or exchange an item.

You also have the option of ordering online. No receipt is required for these purchases, just use the online code (NFACS) so your purchases will be credited to Assumption School, and they will calculate the total online purchases. The dates for online purchases are also Nov. 15-18 only.
