### Literacy and Numeracy

**Increasing the percentage of students achieving at or above the provincial standard with specific emphasis on students with behaviour or learning disabilities and students enrolled in applied courses**

- Implementation of instructional strategies founded on evidence-based research tailored to student needs
- Identification of key resources to guide effective learning, instruction and assessment
- Professional learning to support curriculum implementation (content of learning) and pedagogical approaches (how learning takes place) to meet student needs

### Student Pathways

**Ensuring successful transitions of all students through engagement of students, staff, families, parishes and communities**

- Fostering opportunities to promote student voice and a culture of student engagement
- Professional learning to enhance programming and opportunities that support students in the development of knowledge and skills related to the four areas of learning in education and career life planning. (Knowing yourself; Exploring opportunities; Making decisions; Setting goals; and Achieving goals and making transitions)
- Professional learning to support early identification of students in need of intervention
- Professional learning to support implementation of appropriate and timely tiered interventions to meet student learning needs
