Initiatives included a revamped Faith Day, International & Native Languages Program extended collaboration, Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) Non-Profit, Alternative Learning Centre relocation, International Collaboration and Innovation Works partnership.

Mental Health & Well-Being Strategic Plan and Indigenous Education Action Plan were created.

We will implement research informed instructional and assessment strategies to support improved student achievement, well-being and reduce achievement gaps

Initiatives included implementation of Year Two of the Provincial Renewed Math Strategy, the expansion of the MindUP social emotional learning program designed to improve learning, attendance and behaviour, and Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST).

Reading intervention teachers in primary grades were introduced, as well as an Early Years School-based Facilitator working in partnership with the Early Years Support Specialist to support Kindergarten classroom teams.

Further implementation of Kagan structures to promote enhanced student engagement to support learning of all students.

Continued training took place for lead learners and teachers to support embedding technology throughout the curriculum.

Continued implementation and use of Google Read-Write to support all students, particularly those with special education needs.

Full implementation and replacement of aging digital projection technology to support collaboration and sharing among educators and students.

Implemented the Recommendations from the East London Accommodation Review, closing two schools and reducing the number of empty pupil places.

Replaced traditional classroom desks with collaborative furniture and flexible seating in 6 schools.

Completed lighting retrofit replacing fixtures with energy efficient LED bulbs to enhance learning environment; reduce electricity use; and reduce carbon footprint.

Began implementation of School Messenger to assist with streamlining the tracking of student attendance and provisions under Safe Arrival.
